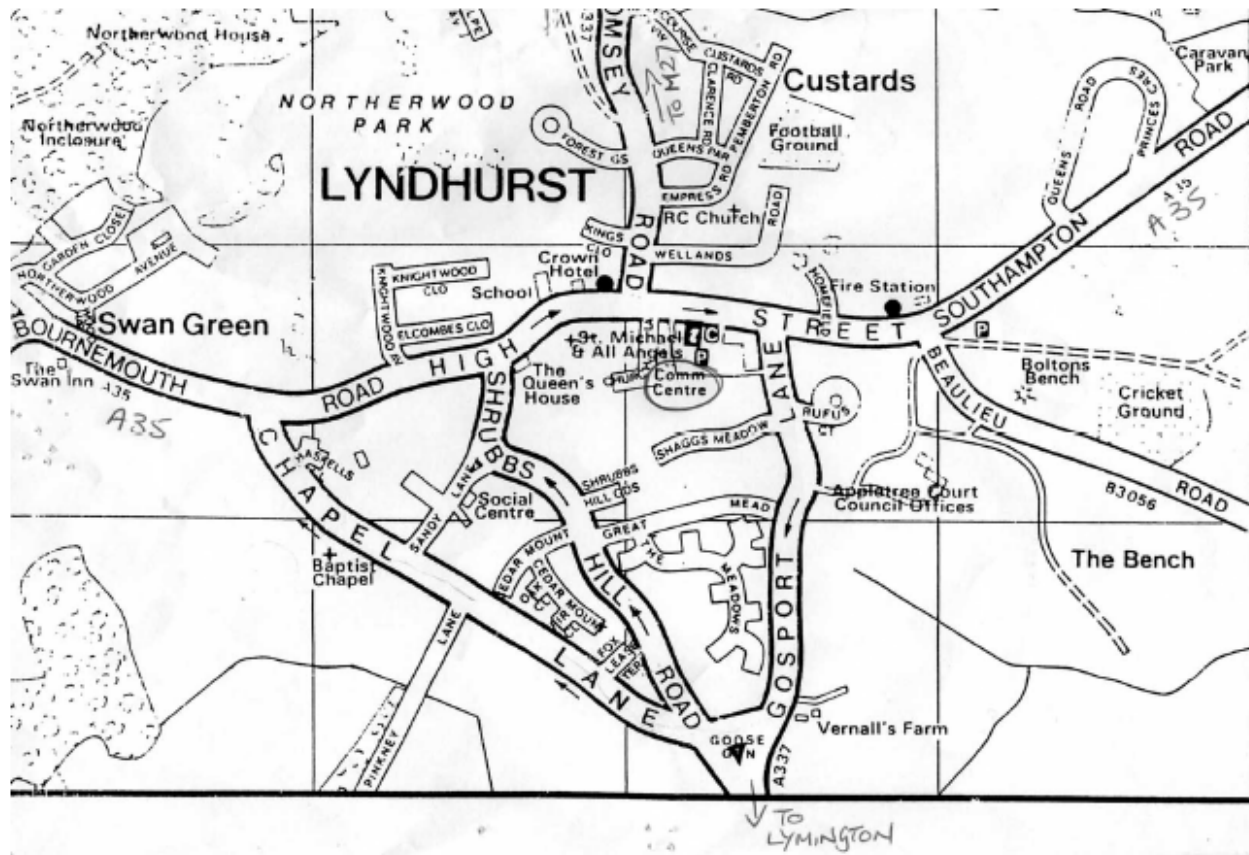

### *How to find us...*



**By train:** the nearest rail stations are Brockenhurst, Beaulieu Road and Ashurst New Forest, all around 3 miles from Lyndhurst.

#### **By car:**

From the M27 – Leave the motorway at Junction 1, turn left at the first roundabout (1st exit) and right at the second (3rd exit), signposted A337 Lyndhurst. Follow the A337 into the village and at the traffic lights turn left into the High Street. The car park entrance is almost immediately on your right. On entering the car park, the Community Centre is on your right.

From Southampton – Take the A35 from Southampton and follow the signposts for Totton and Lyndhurst. On entering the village, turn left into the one way system and immediately cross into the right-hand lane. Turn right into the car park (about 50 yards after the junction). The Community Centre is at the top end of the car park.

Please note that the car park is 'pay and display' and is divided into short and long stay areas. Short and long-stay parking clocks valid for one year are issued by New Forest District Council and are available from their offices. Short-stay clocks are also available from the Community Centre office. The clocks are valid in other NFDC car parks. Parking is free after 6.00pm and at all times for disabled users with a valid blue badge.
